

Jury deliberations expected to resume

Jurors are expected to resume deliberations Wednesday in the trial of three teenage boys charged in the gang rape of a 17-year-old girl.

Judge Michael Malmstadt sent the jurors home Tuesday night after they spent nearly nine hours deliberating.

On trial in Children's Court are a 14-year-old boy and two brothers, ages 14 and 15. The youths have been accused of raping the girl May 13 at

a house on N. 4th St. All three are charged with first-degree sexual assault.

Another boy, who pleaded guilty to his part in the incident, was sentenced Friday to Lincoln Hills School in Irma until he turns 21. Two other boys have pleaded guilty or no contest to charges in the case. Three girls, charged with battery or being a party to a crime, have fled custody.
